An Act Relating to Eligibility for the Elderly Low-cost Drug Program.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

36 MRSA §6162-A, sub-§2, as repealed and replaced by PL
4 1987, c. 876, §§4 and 10, is amended to read:

6 2. **Income.** Eligibility for this program shall--be is
determined by the same income levels as eligibility for elderly
8 households is determined under chapter 907; except that, for a
9 household containing a person 75 years of age or older, the
10 eligibility level for a single-member household is \$9,000 and the
11 eligibility level for a household with 2 or more members is
12 \$12,000.

16 **STATEMENT OF FACT**

18 This bill provides new income eligibility levels for the
elderly low-cost drug program for households containing persons
20 75 years of age or older. The new levels are \$9,000 for a
single-member household and \$12,000 for a household with 2 or
22 more members.
