COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to S.P. 215, L.D. 542, Bill, "An Act to Ban Smoking in Laundromats"

Amend the bill by inserting at the end before the statement of fact the following:

FISCAL NOTE

This bill prohibits smoking in self-service laundries and creates a new civil violation and forfeiture. The additional work load and administrative costs associated with a minimal number of new cases filed in District Court as a result of the new violation will be absorbed within the budgeted resources of the Judicial Department. There will also be a minor increase in General Fund revenue from the collection of additional fines.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment adds a fiscal note to the bill.
