An Act to Amend the Composition of the Board of Trustees of the Maine
Technical College System.



Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

2 Sec. 1. 20-A MRSA §12705, first ¶, as enacted by PL 1985, c.
4 695, §11, is amended to read:

6 The board of trustees shall--be is the policy-making
8 authority of the system.

10 Sec. 2. 20-A MRSA §12705, sub-§1, as amended by PL 1989, c.
12 700, Pt. A, §67, is repealed.

14 Sec. 3. 20-A MRSA §12705, sub-§1-A is enacted to read:

16 1-A. Membership. The board of trustees consists of 8
18 appointed voting members and one ex officio voting member as
20 follows:

22 A. One each from the field of business and industry, the
24 field of labor and the field of education;

26 B. The Commissioner of Education, or the commissioner's
28 successor, who shall serve ex officio; and

30 C. Five from the general public.

32 Sec. 4. 20-A MRSA §12705, sub-§2, as enacted by PL 1985, c.
34 695, §11, is amended to read:

36 2. Appointment; terms. Members of the board of trustees
38 shall-be are appointed by the Governor to 4-year terms of office,
40 subject to review by the joint standing committee of the
42 Legislature having jurisdiction over education matters and to
44 confirmation by the Legislature. No classified or unclassified
46 employee of the State or person who holds elected state office
48 may serve on the board of trustees, with the exception of the ex
50 officio members member.

52 Sec. 5. Reorganization deadline. The reorganization of the
membership of the Board of Trustees of the Maine Technical
College System pursuant to section 3 of this Act must take place
within 90 days of the effective date of this Act. Members who
are not eligible to serve as a result of the changes made in this
Act shall serve until new members have been appointed.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill revises the composition of the Board of Trustees
of the Maine Technical College System by removing 2 ex officio
members and replacing members who serve on other boards with
members from the general public.
