An Act to Abolish the Pheasant Stamp Program.

	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2 4	Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §7076, sub-§4, as amended by PL 1989, c. 493, §11, is further amended to read:
6	4. Resident disabled war veterans. A complimentary license
8	to hunt or fish, or a combination hunting and fishing license, and,-if-requested,-a-pheasant-hunting-permit and a muzzle-loading hunting license under section 7107-A shall <u>must</u> be issued to any
10	resident of Maine who:
12	A. Is a veteran, as defined in Title 37-B, section 505, subsection 1, paragraph A, subparagraph (5);
14	B. Has a service-connected disability evaluated at 70% or
16	more as a result of honorable military service;

	D. Applies for that license to the commissioner.
