judgments of less than \$5,000----For--these--judgments, except civil actions involving a contract or note that contains a provision relating to interest, interest shall-accrue accrues only from the date on which the complaint is filed and at a fixed

rate of 8% per year.

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### STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill makes clear that for judgments of less than 16 \$5,000, except in civil actions involving a contract or note 18 containing interest provisions, prejudgment interest is computed at 8% and only from the date the complaint is filed.
