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2. The net public safety expense submitted by the City of Augusta must be reviewed, certified as appropriate and authorized by the Bureau of Public Improvements; and

3. The proportional share is limited to the value of the assigned risk assessment of state-owned, tax-exempt buildings in the Capitol Area.

Further, this amendment places a cap of 10% of the amount 10 determined through the formula on the sum of the reimbursement and establishes an effective date of July 1, 1992. The amendment 12 also adds an appropriation section and a fiscal note.
