COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 411, L.D. 594, Bill, "An Act to Share Proportionately the Public Safety Costs for the Capitol Area"

Amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and before the statement of fact and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 1. 5 MRSA §1742-E is enacted to read:

§1742-E. Capitol Area public safety expenses

Effective July 1, 1992, the Bureau of Public Improvements shall review, authorize and reimburse the City of Augusta for a proportional share of the public safety expenses incurred from providing public safety services to the Capitol Area, defined in Title 1, section 814. The amount of the reimbursement may not exceed 10% of the product of the net public safety expense multiplied by the proportional share, as defined in this section.

1. Net public safety expense. Net public safety expense is the total actual public safety expense, minus any fees collected, for the fiscal year 2 years earlier than the payment year. The net public safety expense must be submitted by the City of Augusta and certified as appropriate public safety expense by the Bureau of Public Improvements.

2. Proportional share. Proportional share is the value of the assigned risk assessment of tax-exempt, state-owned buildings as certified by the insurer of the buildings in the Capitol Area divided by the sum of:
