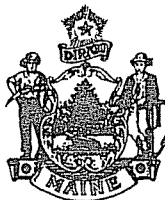

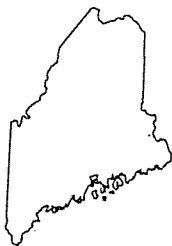

An Act to Share Proportionately the Public Safety Costs for the Capitol Area.



2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

4 5 MRSA §1742-D is enacted to read:

6 **§1742-D. Capitol Area public safety expenses**

8 The Bureau of Public Improvements shall reimburse the City
10 of Augusta for a proportional share of the public safety expenses
12 incurred from providing public safety services to the Capitol
14 Area, defined in Title 1, section 814. The formula for
16 determining the share is calculated as follows.

18 1. Public safety expense. The public safety expense in the
20 formula is the total public safety expense for the fiscal year 2
22 years earlier than the payment year, certified by the City of
24 Augusta. It is multiplied by the proportional share.

26 2. Proportional share. The proportional share of the
28 formula is the value of the assigned risk assessment certified by
30 the insurer of the buildings in the Capitol Area divided by the
32 sum of :

34 A. The state equalized property value for the City of
Augusta; and

B. The value of the assigned risk assessment certified by
the insurer of the buildings in the Capitol Area.

36 **STATEMENT OF FACT**

38 The bill requires the State to reimburse the City of Augusta
40 for a proportional share of the expense of providing public
42 safety services to the Capitol Area.
