COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 414, L.D. 597, Bill, "An Act Requiring Motor Vehicle Operators to Furnish Their Date of Birth upon the Request of a Law Enforcement Officer"

Amend the bill by inserting at the end before the statement of fact the following:

FISCAL NOTE

This bill establishes a new Class E crime for motor vehicle operators failing to give their date of birth when requested by a law enforcement officer. There will be a minimal number of new cases filed in District Court as a result. The additional work load and administrative costs associated with these few cases will be absorbed within the budgeted resources of the Judicial Department.'
