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An Act Requiring Motor Vehicle Operators to Furnish Their Date of  
Birth upon the Request of a Law Enforcement Officer.

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2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **29 MRSA §2501, 3rd ¶**, as enacted by PL 1981, c. 117, §1, is  
amended to read:

6 Whoever, while operating a vehicle in violation of this  
8 Title, fails or refuses, when requested by an officer authorized  
to make arrests, to give his the operator's correct name and  
10 address and date of birth is guilty of a Class E crime.

12 **STATEMENT OF FACT**

14 This bill requires all motor vehicle operators to give their  
16 date of birth when requested by a law enforcement officer.
