IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND NINETY-ONE

An Act to Provide for Local Control in the Selection of Artists and Writers for Funding.



Be i	it	enacted	by	the	People	of	the	State	of	Maine	as	follows	:
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27 MRSA §404, sub-§1, as enacted by PL 1965, c. 499, §1, is amended to read:

1. Encouragement. To take such steps as may be necessary and appropriate to encourage and stimulate public interest and participation in the cultural heritage and programs of our State and to expand the state's State's cultural resources. Any funding of the activities of artists and writers must be solely through the auspices of sponsoring nonprofit agencies, with the nonprofit agencies having approval of the artists and writers involved. The State may not exercise preapproval of artists and writers; and

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill ensures that the selection of artists and writers and their activities remains an autonomous function of the nonprofit agency requesting sponsorship funding through the Maine Arts Commission.
