22	A. Vehicles equipped and used for plowing snow on other than public ways may be equipped with an auxiliary rotary
24	flashing light, which shall must be mounted on top of the vehicle in such a manner as to emit an amber beam of light
26	over a 360degree 360° angle, or an amber strobe, or combination of strobes, that emits as a minimum a beam of
28	1.000.000 candlepower and that provides visible light coverage over a 360° range. The lighting shall must be in
30	use only on a public way when the vehicle is entering the public way in the course of plowing private driveways and
32	other off-highway locations.'
