An Act Regarding the Licensing of Nurses.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 32 MRSA §2202, as amended by PL 1985, c. 724, §19, is further amended to read: 4

§2202. Licenses; examination 6

8 The applicant shall-be is required to pass a written examination in such subjects deemed necessary by the board nesessary to determine the fitness of the applicant to practice 10 professional nursing. Upon successfully passing such theexamination, the board shall issue to the applicant a license to 12 practice professional nursing as a registered nurse, the license to be in force-for a period of at-least one year until-the-birth 14 date-of-the--licensee from the date of issuance. The initial license is renewable as provided in section 2206. 16

Sec. 2. 32 MRSA §2206, as amended by PL 1989, c. 609, §§3 and 4, is further amended to read:

§2206. Renewals

The license of every registered nurse licensed under this 24 chapter shall-be-renewed-annually is renewable every 3 years, except as otherwise provided. At least 30 days before the 3rd 26 anniversary of that--person's--birth the issuance date of a registered nurse's present license, the board shall mail an application for renewal of license to each professional nurse who 28 holds a valid license, -- which. The application shall must be 30 mailed to the most recent address of that person as it appears on the records of the board. That person shall complete the renewal 32 application and return it to the board with a renewal fee of \$20 \$60 before the 3rd anniversary of the issuance date of that 34 person's birth present license. Upon receipt of the application and fee, the board shall verify the accuracy of the application 36 and issue to the applicant a certificate of renewal of license for the-year a period of 3 years, expiring on the 3rd anniversary 38 of the applicant's-birth date of issuance.

Any registered nurse who fails to renew the license as provided may be reinstated by the board on satisfactory explanation for failure to renew the license and on payment of a reinstatement fee of \$10, in addition to the current renewal fee.

Any person practicing professional nursing during the time his the person's license has lapsed shall-be is considered an illegal practitioner and shall-be is subject to the penalties provided for violations of this chapter.

A person who is not engaged in professional nursing in the 50 State shall is not be required to pay a renewal fee for as long 52 as he the person does not practice, but shall notify the board of

his inactive status in writing. Prior to resumption of his the practice of professional nursing, that person shall-be is required to notify the board and remit a renewal fee for the current annual period.

Any practical nurse who fails to renew the license as 46 provided may be reinstated by the board on satisfactory explanation for failure to renew the license and on payment of a 48 reinstatement fee of \$10, in addition to the renewal fee.

Any person practicing nursing as a licensed practical nurse during the time his the person's license has lapsed shall-be is

considered an illegal practitioner and shall-be <u>is</u> subject to the penalties provided for violations of this chapter.

A person who is not engaged in practical nursing in the State shall <u>is</u> not be required to pay a renewal fee as long as he
<u>the person</u> does not practice, but shall notify the board of his inactive status in writing prior to the expiration date of his <u>that person's</u> current license. Before the resumption of practice as a licensed practical nurse and transfer to active status, that person shall--be is required to notify the board, complete a renewal application and remit the current renewal fee.

STATEMENT OF FACT

16 Currently, registered nurses and practical nurses must renew their licenses every year. This bill provides a 3 year renewal 18 period. Also, the licensing fee has been adjusted to reflect the longer licensing period.
