Sec. 2. 24-A MRSA §2834, 2nd ¶, as enacted by PL 1975, c. 770, 14 \$108, is amended to read:

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The coverage for a newly born children-shall child must consist of coverage of injury or sickness, including the necessary care and treatment of medically diagnosed congenital defects and birth abnormalities. Coverage for a newly born child must be provided at 100% of the costs for all inpatient hospital care and attending physician costs prior to the initial discharge from the hospital.
