6	from state road weight laws. There will be a minimal reduction in the number of traffic infractions filed in District Court as a
8	result of the exemptions. This reduction will not significantly decrease the workload and administrative costs of the District
10	Courts.'
12	STATEMENT OF FACT

	This amendment adds an exclusion from weight limits for any
16	vehicles engaged in emergency maintenance of a public way, and clarifies that fire-fighting vehicles with equipment that meet
18	National Fire Protection Association standards are exempt from gross axle weight limits. The amendment repeals a section
20	regarding a weight exemption for snowplows and consolidates it with the 2 new exemptions in one section. The amendment also
22	adds a fiscal note.
