COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 447, L.D. 637, Bill, "An Act Relating to the Restoration of Drivers' Licenses"

Amend the bill by inserting before the statement of fact the following:

This bill eliminates the DEEP completion requirement when a person is acquitted of the charge of operating under the influence or when the charge is dismissed. The decline in fee collections will reduce General Fund revenue by \$123,506 in fiscal year 1991-92 and \$164,675 in fiscal year 1992-93.
