## STATE OF MAINE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES 115TH LEGISLATURE FIRST REGULAR SESSION

COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 450, L.D. 640, Bill, "An Act to Amend the Election Laws Relating to Ballot Counting"

Amend the bill by inserting at the end before the statement of fact the following:

## **FISCAL NOTE**

This bill provides that the Commission on Governmental 22 Ethics and Election Practices shall investigate charges that a person ineligible to serve as an election official took part in counting of election ballots and establishes a new Class E 24 The Commission on Governmental Ethics and Election crime. Practices can absorb the tasks associated with implementing the 26 provisions of this bill if current staffing levels are not decreased. The Governor's current services budget proposal for 28 the commission recommends reducing a full-time position to 30 part-time, which will impact the commission's ability to fulfill these tasks. This bill individually does not warrant providing 32 an additional appropriation. The required General Fund appropriations will depend on the cumulative effect of all legislation affecting the Commission on Governmental Ethics and 34 Election Practices.

There will be a minimal number of new cases filed in 38 District Court as a result of the violation. The additional workload and administrative costs associated with these few cases 40 will be absorbed within the budgeted resources of the Judicial Department. The Department of the Attorney General will absorb 42 the costs associated with prosecuting cases referred by the commission.'

## STATEMENT OF FACT

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This amendment adds a fiscal note to the bill.
