of title for vehicles over 10 years old but less than 25 years old. These amounts will provide for a Title Examiner and general operating funds to handle the anticipated increase in volume of requests for certificates. The establishment of the \$40 fee for classic vehicles and antique automobiles will also generate additional Highway Fund revenue of \$112,000 in fiscal year 1991-92 and \$60,000 in fiscal year 1992-93.

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## STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment replaces the bill. It permits the Secretary of State to issue a warranty title for a classic vehicle more than 10 years old but not old enough to be an antique auto or horseless carriage. The amendment sets the fee for a warranty title for classic vehicles, antique autos and horseless carriages at \$40. The amendment also adds an allocation and fiscal note to the bill.
