An Act to Amend the Prohibition Against the Sale of Liquor on Sundays.



	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	28-A MRSA §4, sub-§1, ¶A, as enacted by PL 1987, c. 45, Pt.
4	A, §4, is amended to read:
6	A. Licensees may not sell liquor on Sunday between the hours of 6 a.m. and 12-neen 9 a.m.

12	Under current law, liquor may not be sold on Sundays between
14	the hours of 6 a.m. and 12 noon. This bill changes those hours to 6 a.m. and 9 a.m.
