#### <u>§6-A. Delivery of income maintenance programs</u>

ByJuly 1, 1993, the commissioner shall organize the8department's income maintenance programs in a manner that allows<br/>citizens to apply for all income maintenance programs10simultaneously. Each income maintenance caseworker must be<br/>trained to determine eligibility in all income maintenance12programs administered by the department. Income maintenance<br/>programs include, but are not limited to, the following: food14stamps; aid to families with dependent children; medical<br/>assistance; welfare employment, education and training; and16additional support for people in retraining and education.

#### STATEMENT OF FACT

Presently, applicants for income maintenance programs administered by the Department of Human Services must apply to several programs separately, often meeting with several caseworkers in several locations. The bill requires that caseworkers be trained to determine eligibility in all programs so that applicants may apply for all programs simultaneously.
