COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 464, L.D. 658, Bill, "An Act to Clarify the Lien Rights of Water Utilities"

Amend the bill in that part designated "§6111." in the last paragraph in the last line (page 1, line 20 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "district" the following: ', except that a sanitary district lien created under Title 38, section 1208 has priority over a water utility lien created under this section'

STATEMENT OF FACT

The original bill establishes provisions for water utility liens styled on the provisions for sanitary district liens under the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 38, section 1028. This amendment clarifies the priority between sanitary district and water utility liens. The amendment provides that a sanitary district lien has priority over a water utility lien.
