Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

\$1308-A. Federal prevailing wage determinations; minimum

The bureau may not establish a prevailing wage that is less than that determined by the federal Department of Labor for the same occupational trade, geographic area and type of project.

STATEMENT OF FACT

14 This bill prevents the State's prevailing wage law from 16 being less effective than federal Davis-Bacon law so that wages and fringe benefits paid on state public works projects must be 18 at least equivalent to wages and fringe benefits paid on federal Davis-Bacon projects.
