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STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment replaces the bill. The amendment requires the Commissioner of Environmental Protection to prepare an analysis of the staff and financial resources needed by the 10 Department of Environmental Protection to assume responsibility for the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System currently 12 administered by the federal Environmental Protection Agency under the federal Water Pollution Control Act. The commissioner is 14 directed to submit the analysis to the Legislature for review in 16 1992.
