HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 507,
L.D. 701, Bill, "An Act to Provide Community Rating of Health
Insurance Providers"

Amend the amendment by striking out all of the fiscal note
and inserting in its place the following:

FISCAL NOTE

APPROPRIATIONS/ALLOCATIONS

Other Funds \$70,000

The community rating system proposed in this bill will
result in some insurers leaving the small group health insurance
market and, consequently, in some individuals becoming
uninsured. This will reduce General Fund revenues from premium
tax collections by approximately \$192,000 annually beginning in
fiscal year 1993-94.

The Bureau of Insurance will require an allocation of
available Other Special Revenue in the amount of \$70,000 in
fiscal year 1992-93 for one-time consulting services necessary to
assist the bureau in preparing the report specified in section 6
of the bill.'
