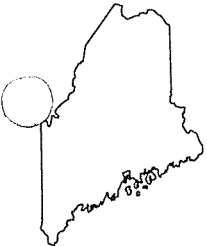

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

2
4 20-A MRSA §8453, sub-§1, as enacted by PL 1981, c. 693, §§5
and 8, is amended to read:

6 1. Election by school board. At least one person in a
8 representative grouping within a vocational region shall must be
a-member-of elected by a school board of a school administrative
10 unit within the representative grouping.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill allows local school boards to elect any interested
citizen to the cooperative board rather than requiring that the
representative be a member of the local school board.
