6	9. Tax maps. Municipal assessing units do not necessarily
	have to maintain tax maps but, if they do, then current tax maps
8	and amendments as of April 1st of each year must be filed by each
	municipality in the registry of deeds.

	This bill requires that tax maps and amendments to tax maps
16	be filed in the registry of deeds by April 1st of each year.
