5 F. An applicant is not eligible for coverage for 3rd-party  
6 damage costs under this section if that applicant owns or  
7 leases more than 3 facilities.

10 **STATEMENT OF FACT**

12 This bill limits the eligibility for coverage of 3rd-party  
13 damage costs from the Ground Water Oil Clean-up Fund to  
14 applicants who own or lease 3 or fewer facilities.
