Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

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5 MRSA §1886, sub-§5, ¶C, as enacted by PL 1985, c. 785, Pt.
A, §78, is amended to read:

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C. The development of computer systems and computer
programs, except that the names of individuals,
corporations, agencies and other entities must be listed as
they are legally stated: first name first and last name
last;

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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This bill mandates that the Office of Information Services
set and maintain a written standard for all computer programs
used by the State, its departments and agencies that requires
that the names of individuals, corporations and agencies be
listed as they are legally stated: first name first and last
name last.

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
