Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

35-A MRSA §7506 is enacted to read:

§7506. Information delivery services

7 Every telephone company operating in the State shall provide
8 customers the option of having access to information delivery
9 services blocked. A telephone company may not collect any fee
10 from the customer for blocking access to information delivery
11 services. The commission shall, by rule or order, establish a
12 definition of "information delivery services" that includes,
13 without limitation, services accessed by 900 numbers and 976
14 numbers.

STATEMENT OF FACT

19 This bill requires telephone companies to provide customers,
20 without charge, the option of having access to information
21 delivery services blocked. This bill requires the Public
22 Utilities Commission to establish by rule or order a definition
23 of "information delivery services" that includes, without
24 limitation, services accessed by 900 and 976 numbers.
