Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

2
4 14 MRSA §7554-A, sub-§2, as enacted by PL 1973, c. 81, is amended to read:

6 2. **Payment.** The appropriate department may make reasonable
8 payment to affected property owners ~~net--to--exceed--\$100--as--a~~
10 landmark--location--allowance for the cost of reestablishing the
landmark location.

12 **STATEMENT OF FACT**

14 State departments are authorized to pay for the
16 reestablishment of a landmark location destroyed in the process
of any public improvement. Since 1973, the maximum for this cost
18 has been set at \$100. This bill replaces the \$100 maximum, which
is no longer reasonable, and allows the payment of reasonable
cost for this work.
