Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

6 7. Investigation. ~~Investigate--all~~ Assist the National
8 Transportation Safety Board as needed in the investigation of
10 aircraft accidents and incidents within in the State;

12 STATEMENT OF FACT

14 This bill changes the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 6 to
16 recognize that the National Transportation Safety Board is
18 responsible for all aircraft accident investigations and is
20 charged with making final determination as to cause. This bill
further recognizes that the Department of Transportation's
appropriate role is to provide assistance as needed to federal
authorities in carrying out their responsibilities.
