Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows: 2 6 MRSA §17, sub-§7, as enacted by PL 1977, c. 678, §30, is 4 amended to read: 6 7. Investigation. Investigate -- all Assist the National Transportation Safety Board as needed in the investigation of 8 aircraft accidents and incidents within in the State; 10 12 STATEMENT OF FACT

14 This bill changes the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 6 to recognize that the National Transportation Safety Board is 16 responsible for all aircraft accident investigations and is charged with making final determination as to cause. This bill 18 further recognizes that the Department of Transportation's appropriate role is to provide assistance as needed to federal 20 authorities in carrying out their responsibilities.
