Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not
2 become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted
as emergencies; and

Whereas, it is necessary that the provisions of the
6 journeyman-in-training electricians' licensing laws be continued
without interruption; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts
10 create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of
Maine and require the following legislation as immediately
12 necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and
safety; now, therefore,

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

32 MRSA §1202, sub-§1, ¶D, as repealed and replaced by PL
18 1989, c. 878, Pt. A, §92, is amended to read:

20 D. For a journeyman-in-training electricians' electrician's
license, a person must be a graduate of an accredited Maine
22 technical college electrical program or a
vocational-electrical program of the Department of
24 Corrections, receive a passing grade on the journeyman
examination and complete 2,000 hours of experience. This
26 ~~provision shall be reviewed by the joint standing committee~~
~~of the Legislature having jurisdiction over business~~
28 ~~legislation by March 1, 1991, and, unless continued by law,~~
~~shall terminate at this time.~~

Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the
32 preamble, this Act takes effect when approved.

STATEMENT OF FACT

38 This bill ensures continuance without interruption of the
journeyman-in-training level of licensure that has proven to be
40 an appropriate step in the electrician education program.
