oversight	duties ;	permitted	the boar	ds of th	e mental	health
institutes	to be d	isbanded.	However,	it was n	ot the ir	itent to
remove the	boards	of visito	s of othe	r institut	cions. Th	nis bill
reestablish	es the	boards of	visitors	, except	for the	Augusta
Mental Heal	th Insti	tute and t	he Bangor	Mental Hea	lth Insti	tute.

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
