COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A " to S.P. 282, L.D. 741, Bill, "An Act to Amend the Laws Governing the Bath Children's Home"

Amend the bill by inserting before the statement of fact the following:

**Sec. 3. Transition.** The current director of the Bath Children's Home may, at the director's option, remain in the classified service and a member of the same collective bargaining unit and retain all rights, privileges and benefits provided by collective bargaining agreements as long as the director remains in the current position.

**FISCAL NOTE**

This bill creates a director position for the Bath Children's Home and allows the Commissioner of Mental Health and Mental Retardation to appoint and set the salary for the director. The current services budget provides funds for the salary of the director position, identified as the superintendent, at salary range 25, step G, in the amount of \$36,962. If the commissioner approves and sets the salary of the director at any level less or greater than this amount, an adjustment to the Personal Services appropriation will be required.'

**STATEMENT OF FACT**

This amendment permits the current director of the Bath Children's Home to remain in the classified service and adds a fiscal note.
