COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "/ to H.P. 520, L.D. 748, Bill, "An Act Related to Theft of Services for Rental Property"

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Amend the bill in subsection 3 in the 5th and 6th lines 16 (page 1, lines 10 and 11 in L.D.) by striking out the following: 18 "the accommodations retained by a tenant holding possession after the expiration or termination of a tenancy," and inserting in its 'the value of accommodations vacated by a 20 place the following: tenant prior to the expiration of a leasehold interest, except 22 when the tenant gives proper notice in accordance with the terms of the lease,'

Further amend the bill by inserting before the statement of fact the following:

## **•FISCAL NOTE**

The additional work load and administrative costs associated 32 with a minimal number of additional cases filed as a result of the requirements will be absorbed within the budgeted resources of the Judicial Department.

. The appointment of court-appointed counsel for indigent 36 defendants who are charged with this crime will result in costs 38 to the Judicial Department. A General Fund appropriation to the Judicial Department may be necessary for the indigent defense program once the cumulative effect of all legislation for which 40 court-appointed counsel for indigent defendants must be provided 42 is known.

44 The Governor's proposed adjusted current services budget affects the indigent defense program by discontinuing appointment 46 of counsel for certain crimes.'

COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "H" to H.P. 520, L.D. 748

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## STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment amends the bill to provide that the crime of 6 theft of services is committed by a person renting property who has a lease and vacates property prior to the expiration of the 8 lease, when that person has not given proper notice. Under this amendment, if the person vacates without notice by a means 10 designed to avoid due payment for the remaining term of the lease, the person has committed the crime of theft of services. 12 The amendment also adds a fiscal note to the bill.
