An Act Related to Theft of Services for Rental Property.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

As used in this section, "services" includes, but is not 3. necessarily limited to, labor, professional service, utility and transportation service, ski lift service, restaurant, hotel, motel, tourist accommodations, the accommodations retained by a tenant holding possession after the expiration or termination of a tenancy, the

supplying of equipment, tools, vehicles or trailers for temporary use, telephone, telegraph, cable television or computer service, gas, electricity, water or steam, admission to entertainment, exhibitions, sporting events or other events or services for which a charge is made.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill amends the Maine Criminal Code to make it clear 22 that the crime of theft of services may be committed by a person renting property who holds onto possession of the property beyond 24 the term of the lease or other period of the tenancy. Under this bill if the person retains possession after the expiration or termination of the tenancy, knowing that to do so is to obtain a 26 service available only for compensation, by a means designed to 28 avoid due payment for the service, the person has committed the crime of theft of services.

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
