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**An Act to Prevent Discrimination against Podiatrists.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

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4 22 MRSA §1811-A is enacted to read:

6 **§1811-A. Discrimination against podiatrists**

8 Hospitals and other institutions licensed under section 1811  
10 may not discriminate against an applicant qualified within the  
12 scope of the applicant's license when considering or acting on an  
14 application for full staff membership or clinical privileges to  
16 practice podiatry. Each applicant must be considered only on the  
18 basis of the applicant's training, current competency and ability.

20 **STATEMENT OF FACT**

22 This bill ensures that all hospitals and other health care  
institutions licensed in the State do not deny employment or  
privileges to podiatrists simply because they are podiatrists.  
This bill requires that each applicant for employment or staff  
privileges be judged only on the basis of the applicant's  
training, competency and ability.
