STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND NINETY-ONE

An Act to Require a Current Tax Map Reference on a Declaration of Value.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

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36 MRSA §4641-D, first ¶, as amended by PL 1989, c. 131, is 4 further amended to read:

б Any A deed, except as provided in this section, shall must, when offered for recording, be accompanied by a statement or 8 declaration prepared in duplicate and signed, subject to the penalties of perjury, by the parties to the transaction or their 10 authorized representatives, declaring the consideration for the thereby transferred and indicating the taxpayer property 12 identification numbers of the grantor and grantee. The statement or declaration shall must include reference to the appropriate tax map and parcel number as shown on the current tax map 14 recorded in the Registry of Deeds unless no tax map exists that. 16 includes that property, in which event the declaration shall must indicate that no appropriate tax map exists. The exceptions to the foregoing are the following: 18

STATEMENT OF FACT

The bill requires tax, map and lot numbers to be shown on the declaration of value form.
