± U	commissioners shall notify all municipal officers in the
48	county to caucus by county commissioner districts at a
	specified date, time and place for the purpose of electing
50	at least 3 residents of the district of voting age as
	members of the county budget advisory committee. At least 2
52	of the persons nominated must not be municipal officials. A

- county commissioner shall serve as nonvoting moderator for that county commissioner's district caucus. Nominations must be received from the floor and require a majority vote of those present to be approved. The names of those duly elected by the caucus must be recorded and forwarded to the county commissioners.
 - B. The Knox County legislative delegation shall select annually one member of the delegation who resides in Knox County to serve on the county budget advisory committee.
- C. A municipality may not have more than one county budget advisory committee member.
- 2. Duties. The county budget advisory committee shall review the budget and estimates, including the salaries for county officers, in preparation for review by the county commissioners. The county commissioners shall approve a final county budget.
- 3. Term of office. The term of office for county budget advisory committee members is 3 years, except that the member of the legislative delegation serves for a one-year period.
- 4. Vacancies. If a county budget advisory committee member who is a municipal official ceases to be a municipal official during the term of membership, the committee member shall vacate membership and the next district caucus shall elect a qualified municipal officer to serve for the remainder of the unexpired term. All other vacancies occurring on the county budget advisory committee must be filled by the committee for the balance of the unexpired term. The person appointed to fill the vacant office must be from the same municipality as the person vacating the office.
- 5. Expenses. Members shall serve without compensation, but are entitled to reimbursement from the county treasury for expenses lawfully incurred by them in the performance of their duties.
- 6. Meetings. The county budget advisory committee shall conduct its meetings in public at the county courthouse. The county commissioners shall direct the county clerk to call an organizational meeting of the county budget advisory committee at least 90 days before the end of the county's fiscal year. The county commissioners shall provide the committee with necessary clerical assistance, office expenses, suitable meeting space and access to county files and information. The county budget advisory committee shall select its own chair, vice-chair and secretary. The county budget advisory committee shall adopt its own rules or procedures and bylaws.

	§885. Budget estimate; submission to county budget advisory

	The county commissioners shall submit a budget estimate to
	the county budget advisory committee no later than October 1st
	for the coming year. The committee shall review the budget
	<u>estimate and make recommendations to the commissioners prior to </u>
	November 15th. The county commissioners shall act on the budget
	in a timely fashion and, in any event, not later than December
	15th of the budget year.
	§886. Final budget estimates; filing
	A copy of the final budget estimates must be filed on forms
	approved by the Department of Audit with the State Auditor who
3	shall retain them for 3 years.
	Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the
	preamble, this Act takes effect when approved.
