| 2 | 2. Operation. Each school administrative unit shall ensure that the heating, ventilation and air-conditioning system is: |

| 38 | STATEMENT OF FACT |
| 40 | |
| 42 | The original bill established air quality standards for school buildings that are built or substantially renovated in the |
| 44 | future by applying current American Society of Heating, Refrigeration and Air Conditioning Engineers, Inc., ASHRAE, standards. This amendment addresses air quality in existing |
| 46 | schools by requiring school officials to operate and maintain currently installed mechanically driven heating, ventilation and |
| 48 | air-conditioning systems in accordance with building standard |
| 50 | codes on air quality in existence when the school was built or the system installed. School units are also required to inspect |
| 52 | and, if necessary, repair air quality systems annually and to make their records regarding inspection and repair available to |

the public. The amendment also corrects an incorrect reference to ASHRAE standards in the original bill.
