## COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 559, L.D. 802

The estimated cost to the Secretary of State if one to 6 referenda are enacted is \$95,000. Each additional referendum costs an additional \$6,500.

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There will be additional future costs to the General Fund to operate and staff these facilities once the construction is completed. These costs can not be determined at this time.'

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## STATEMENT OF FACT

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This amendment reduces the amount of the bond from \$35,000,000 to \$5,500,000 by deleting the proposal for construction of a medium security correctional facility, reducing the proposed number of diversion and restitution centers from 2 to one, eliminating the feasibility study and revising the costs of other proposed facilities or renovations. The amendment also reduces the term of the bond and deletes Part B and adds a fiscal note to the bill.
