Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

7 3. Failure to approve a budget. If the total budget
8 article fails to receive a majority vote at the referendum, the
9 board of directors shall consider the prior year's budget to be
10 the approved budget for the next school year.

14 STATEMENT OF FACT

15 This bill provides that if the total budget article fails to
16 receive a majority vote at referendum, the board of directors
17 must consider the prior year's budget to be the approved budget
