An Act to Promote Safety in Hunting.



Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

12 MRSA §7406, sub-§12-A is enacted to read:

12-A. Hunting near where people congregate. A person may not hunt within 1,000 feet of any home, business, school or other place where people live or congregate on a regular and systematic basis.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill prohibits hunting within 1,000 feet of places where people live or congregate on a regular and systematic basis.
