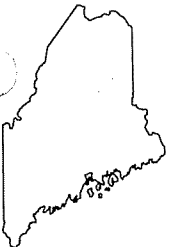

**An Act to Issue Doe Permits to Physically Disabled Persons Upon
Request from the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife.**



Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

12 MRSA §7076, sub-§14 is enacted to read:

6 14. Physically disabled persons. Upon application to the
8 commissioner, a permit to hunt antlerless deer must be issued to
10 any physically disabled person who holds a valid general hunting
12 license. The applicant shall specify the district in which the
applicant wishes to hunt antlerless deer. For purposes of this
section, "antlerless deer" means any deer that does not have
antlers or any deer that has antlers less than 3 inches in length
measured from the skull.

16 **STATEMENT OF FACT**

18 This bill provides that disabled persons who possess a valid
20 general hunting license and make application to the Commissioner
of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife must be issued a permit to hunt
antlerless deer.
