14. Physically disabled persons. Upon application to the commissioner, a permit to hunt antlerless deer must be issued to any physically disabled person who holds a valid general hunting license. The applicant shall specify the district in which the applicant wishes to hunt antlerless deer. For purposes of this section, "antlerless deer" means any deer that does not have antlers or any deer that has antlers less than 3 inches in length measured from the skull.

### STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill provides that disabled persons who possess a valid general hunting license and make application to the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife must be issued a permit to hunt antlerless deer.
