## IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND NINETY-ONE

An Act to Prohibit Employers from Harassing Employees Who Are Absent from Work Due to Illness.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows: 2 26 MRSA §597 is enacted to read: 4 §597. Employees absent from work due to illness б An employer may not require an employee to return to work or risk termination if that employee has a note from a physician or 8 other health care provider stating that the employee must be 10 absent from work to recuperate from illness and the employee has taken reasonable steps to make the employer aware that the 12 employee has such a note. Any employer who violates this section commits a civil violation for which a forfeiture not to exceed \$100 may be adjudged. 14 16 STATEMENT OF FACT 18 This bill prohibits an employer from requiring an employee to return to work or risk termination if the employee has a note 20 stating that the employee must remain home to recuperate from 22 illness.

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
