An Act to Repeal the Sunset Provision of Simulcasting Laws.



Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

4 8 MRSA §268, as amended by PL 1989, c. 882, is further
amended to read:

6 **§268. Rules and regulations**

8 The commission shall make rules and regulations for the
10 holding, conducting and operating of all harness horse races or
meets for public exhibition held in this State and for the
12 operation of race tracks on which any such race or meet is held;
notwithstanding any other provision of law, harness horse races
14 or meets held on Sunday shall ~~shall~~ may not commence until the hour of
1 p.m.

16 The commission may authorize licensees of extended meets to
provide for the simulcasting of entire racing cards during the
18 first 6 weeks of each year. ~~This paragraph is repealed January~~
