SENATE AMENDMENT " B " to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 588, L.D. 839, Bill, "An Act to Ensure Early Intervention Services to Eligible Special Needs Children from Birth to Age 5"

Amend the amendment by striking out everything after the title and before the statement of fact and inserting in its place the following:

'Amend the bill by striking out all of the title and substituting the following:

'An Act to Ensure Early Intervention Services to Eligible Special Needs Children from 3 to 5 Years of Age'

Further amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and before the statement of fact and inserting in its place the following:

'Appropriation. The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.
