COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " $\mathcal{H}$ " to H.P. 589, L.D. 840, Bill, "An Act to Provide Greater Public Input into Public Lands Management"

16 Amend the bill by striking out everything the enacting clause and before the statement of fact and inserting in its 18 place the following:

'Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §586, sub-§2, as amended by PL 1989, c. 104, Pt. C, §§8 and 10, is further amended to read:

2. Expenditures from fund. Expenditures from the fund are 24 legislative in subject to approval the same manner as appropriations from the General Fund. No money may be expended 26 without allocation by the Legislature. The joint standing jurisdiction committee of the Legislature having over and financial 28 appropriations affairs must approve the allocations. In addition, the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over natural resource matters 30 must review allocations for the bureau's dedicated funds and any 32 revenues of the bureau from permits, leases, fees and sales. The joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction 34 over natural resource matters must submit a written report to the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction 36 over appropriations and financial affairs on or before March 1st of each year.

Sec. 2. Review formation of advisory committee. The Director of the Bureau of Public Lands shall review and analyze the formation of an advisory committee for the Bureau of Public Lands. The director shall submit recommendations and any necessary implementing legislation to the Joint Standing Committee on Energy and Natural Resources by March 1, 1992.

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## **FISCAL NOTE**

Costs associated with the Joint Standing Committee on Energy and Natural Resources' review of the Bureau of Public Lands revenues and allocations and report to the Joint Standing Committee on Appropriations and Financial Affairs will be absorbed within the legislative budget. The Bureau of Public Lands will be able to absorb the costs required to analyze the formation of an advisory committee and to submit recommendations to the Legislature.'

## STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment replaces the original bill to require adoption of Bureau of Public Lands management plans under the 18 Maine Administrative Procedure Act and to undedicate the bureau's 20 funds. This amendment requires the Joint Standing Committee on Energy and Natural Resources to approve the allocation of funds within the bureau's dedicated funds. It also requires the 22 Director of the Bureau of Public Lands to study the concept of an advisory committee for the Bureau of Public Lands and to bring 24 recommendations and implementing legislation to the Legislature in 1992. This amendment also adds a fiscal note. 26
